## Center for General Education Division of Liberal Education Directives for Establishing the Curriculum Committee

November 16, 2009 Amended and passed by the General Education Committee at its 95<sup>th</sup> meeting

November 24, 2022 Articles 1 and 6 amended and passed by the General Education Committee at its 140<sup>th</sup> meeting

- Article 1 National Taiwan University (NTU)'s Division of Liberal Education ("the Division") of the Center for General Education ("the Center") establishes a Curriculum Committee ("the Committee") responsible for conducting curriculum reviews and evaluations in accordance with Article 2 of the NTU Directives for Establishing Curriculum Committees.
- Article 2 The Committee shall consist of the Division Director as the Committee convener, conveners of liberal education's eight core areas, and a student representative selected by NTU Student Association Resolutions. The attendance of relevant persons may be required if necessary.
- Article 3 Resolutions of the Committee may be made through e-mail or by electronic means.
- Article 4 The responsibilities of the Committee are as follows:
  - 1. Planning and structuring of NTU's general and liberal education (GLE) curricula.
  - 2. Reviewing of the Division's curriculum design and changes.
  - 3. Coordination, integration and improvement of other matters regarding the curriculum or teaching offered by the Division.
- Article 5 The quorum for a Committee meeting shall be at least half the members of the Committee; a resolution shall only be passed by a majority vote of the members present.
- Article 6 The Division of Liberal Education Directives for Establishing the Curriculum Committee shall be passed by the Center Affairs Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation
